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Bicycle Rider Permission 2019 - 2020



Dear Parents/Guardians of bike riders,

As we are settling in to our morning routines we are noticing that more students are choosing to ride their bikes. As stated in previous communication home, parents are asked to designate students as "car, bus, or walkers" to help our staff prepare for the smoothest and safest dismissal for your child. The safety of your child is our number one priority, therefore, we encourage our students to be car or bus riders.

Per our handbook on page 16:

"Students wishing to ride their bicycles to or from school may do so if they are a **fourth grader or older**. No K-3rd grade without **permission from the Principal**. All bicycles must be parked in the proper racks and locked during the school day. If the child misuses the bicycle privilege, it may be revoked at the discretion of the principal. **Students are to walk their bicycles on the sidewalks by the school**. Failure to comply will result in the loss of bike privileges. School personnel cannot be responsible for the theft or damage to any bike."

The safety of your child is our number one concern. It is very important for us to know every student that is choosing to ride bikes to and from school. It is also very important for us to encourage your child to be aware of bicycle safety when riding on the road. Please encourage your child to stay on the sidewalk and out of the road. I have had a couple phone calls concerned about student safety when riding bicycles to and from school because students are not aware of bicycle safety. Therefore, I am requesting that you fill out the bicycle rider permission form below if you would like your child to continue to ride his/her bicycle.
