Dear Parent(s):

During the school year, Reagan students will have the opportunity to take various field trips. Field trips are a part of the academic program we offer students and, as such, a field trip is an extension of the classroom, where students are learning. The board and building policies are in place, and students are expected to reflect the values and pride of Reagan Elementary.

For each individual field trip, the teachers will provide you with the specific information ahead of time. On many fieldtrips, teachers may ask for parent chaperons. A chaperon is an extension of the teacher and, as a volunteer, helps in the teaching of the students. Depending on the field trip, the total number of chaperons will be limited to the actual teaching and supervising need as predetermined between the principal, teachers, and the field trip site.

Chaperones are volunteers; their primary role as an extension of the classroom teacher, is to focus on the students assigned to them by the teaching staff. Due to district liability, chaperones cannot bring relatives or other siblings along on field trips.
