The Ashland City School District Board of Education met for a work session on Monday, February 11, 2019, at the Ashland City School District Central Offices, 1407 Claremont Ave., Dr. James Wolfe, President, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

- I. ROLL CALL** Mr. Mike Heimann, Mr. Bryan Lefelhoc, Mrs. Lindsey Saffle, Mr. Zach Truax, and Dr. James Wolfe were present.
- II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Dr. Wolfe, Board President.
- III. APPROVAL OF AGENDA 2019-02-017** Mrs. Saffle motioned; second by Mr. Truax to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

- Dr. Wolfe – plans for future classroom improvements including additional preschool classes.


E. Musical – Performance is Feb. 22, 23, & 24.
