The design of the school is also **TRANSFORMING**, taking the best from the past Essex Schools and the past Governor's Summer Institutes.

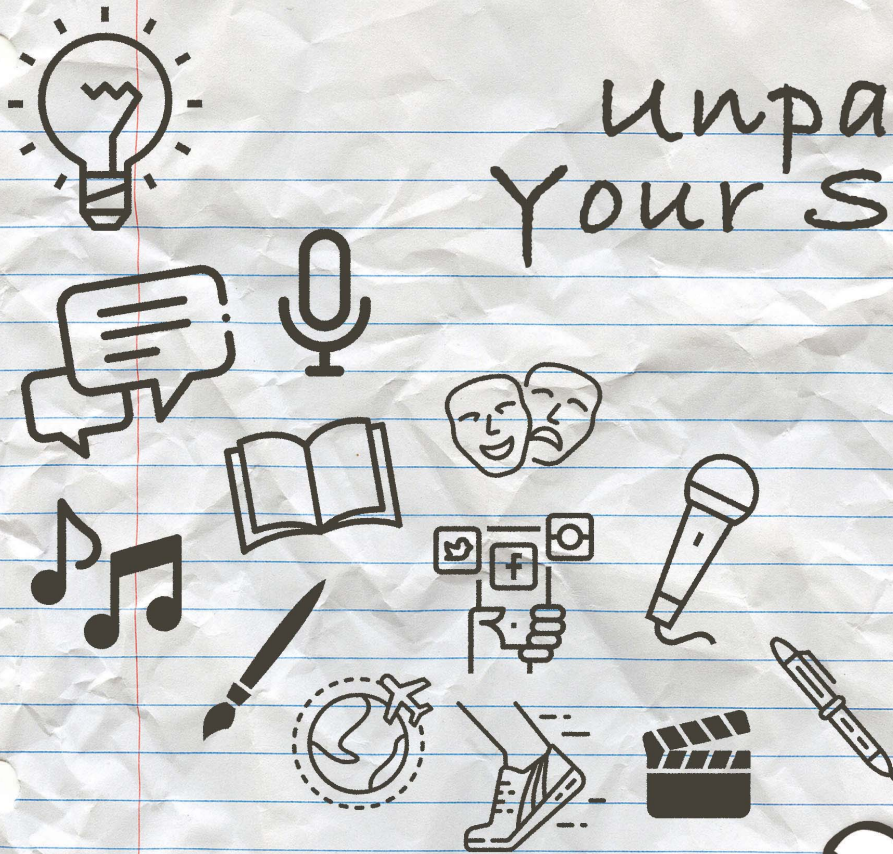

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The purpose of the Essex School is to provide enrichment experiences for rising eleventh and twelfth grade students who are identified as gifted and talented in Ohio
2. The School will operate during June 20-26, 2021 on a virtual platform
3. Those registered will participate in summer enrichment experience that includes activities such as seminars, workshops and extended projects
4. The School will explore academic and/or artistic pursuits at a level not always possible in the typical high school classroom. The topics addressed by the seminars and workshops will reflect the interests of the students, and will have an eye especially on salient contemporary issues.
5. College credit will be available for those who wish to earn one credit hour.; all students will receive a certificate of participation at the conclusion of the School.
6. The cost of the Essex School is \$150.00 This cost can be assumed by family, district, and/or community of applicant. Financial assistance *may* be available for those who qualify. A \$25 nonrefundable deposit is due at the time the registration packet is submitted (checks payable to Ashland University) and the final payment will be due April 15.
