Grades K-3

<u>Cluster grouping</u>-a group of 4-8 identified students placed with a teacher who is highly qualified in gifted instruction.

Grades 4-5

Combined Cluster grouping-two or more groups of 4-8 identified students placed with a teacher who is highly qualified in gifted instruction.

OR

<u>Cluster grouping</u>-a group of 4-8 identified students placed with a teacher who is highly qualified in gifted instruction.

Grades 6-12

<u>Setting</u>: Honors/Advanced classes/AP courses, post-secondary options, cluster grouping <u>Services</u>: services are provided by teachers who are highly qualified in gifted education or have gifted licensure.

<u>Cluster grouping</u>-a group of 4-8 identified students placed with a teacher who is highly qualified in gifted instruction.

-differentiated instruction in which above grade-level instruction is provided.
