### **PERMISSION FORM**

**Mandatory Pre-Tryout Meeting:** At least one parent must attend with student

May 22, 2024 - 5-5:30p - MS Library

**Tryout Clinic Dates:** (MUST ATTEND AT LEAST ONE TO TRYOUT - RECOMMEND ATTENDING BOTH)

May 22, 2024 - 5:30-7p - MS Gym

May 23, 2024 - 5:30-7p - MS Gym

**Tryout/Team Placement Date:**

May 25, 2024 - 9:00am - MS Gym

**Tryout Day Attire:**

Plain fitted black tank top (no designs) tucked into shorts, black shorts, tennis/cheer shoes and hair pulled in slicked back low pony - game ready(bows optional). Stud earrings/ nose studs only.

**Material:**

All material will be taught at the clinic and posted on the cheer website to practice.

**Teacher Evals:**

You will need to reach out to two of your current core (no choir/band/art/etc.) Class teachers and request them to fill out a teacher eval. The QR code to give to your teacher can be found on our website. **These are due no later than May 24th.**

\*if you are currently taking all of your core classes through ccp - please use core teachers from the previous school year.

**Tryout Information**

1. The Ashland cheerleading coaches will choose team members with the assistance of independent judges. These judges will have at least one of the following qualifications: from a known cheerleading organization, coached middle, high school, or collegiate level athletes, or have prior college cheerleading experience.
2. The decisions of the coaches and judges are final. If you have questions concerning the procedures for tryouts and team placements please make sure that you ask them prior to the date of tryouts in May.
3. Cheerleading tryouts are closed to the public, and cheerleaders must be present for the meeting, clinic and tryout, unless a unique situation is approved by the head coach and staff prior to the start of tryout and/or clinic begin.
4. Girls making the squads will need to practice and exhibit the same skills displayed at tryouts throughout the season in which they cheer on the track and/or basketball court. If the cheerleader cannot practice and exhibit the skills, he/she may be ineligible to cheer.
5. All tumbling skills must be performed unaided and without a spotter.
6. At the conclusion of tryouts, team placements will be posted on the cheerleading website/social media by the end of the day.
