- VIII. <u>STANDING AUTHORIZATIONS</u> 2024-01-006 Mrs. Mowry motioned; second by Mrs. Deppert to adopt the following standing authorizations to allow for efficient financial management and full execution of duties by the Treasurer, Board President, and Superintendent.-Motion carried 5-0.
  - 1. <u>Advances on Tax Settlements</u>: Authorization for the Treasurer to secure advances on local taxes from the County Auditor when funds are available and payable to the district.
  - 2. <u>Investment of Inactive Funds</u>: Authorization for the Treasurer to invest inactive and interim funds at the most productive interest rate whenever such funds are available in accordance with the District Investment Policy. The Depository Accounts are with Huntington Bank.
  - 3. <u>Payment of Bills</u>: Authorization for the Treasurer to pay all bills within the limits of the appropriation resolution as bills are received and when, if applicable, the merchandise has been received in good condition.
  - 4. <u>Borrowing Authority</u>: Authorization for the Treasurer and Board President to borrow funds, if needed, within the limitations established by state and federal laws.
  - 5. <u>Issuing Purchase Orders:</u> Authorization for Administration to issue Purchase Orders within adopted appropriations.
  - 6. <u>Employment of Staff</u>: Authorization for the Superintendent, during periods when this Board is not in session, to make offers of employment directly to candidates for either teaching or nonteaching positions on behalf of this Board, and to acknowledge acceptance of such offers on behalf of this Board, subject to a subsequent vote of ratification by this Board; provided however, that upon ratification by this Board, the employment shall be deemed effective as of the date and time of the employee's acceptance of the Superintendent's offer.
  - 7. <u>Accepting Resignations</u>: Authorization for the Superintendent, on behalf of this Board, to accept resignations which have been submitted by employees during times when this Board is not is session, subject to ratification by this Board; provided however, that upon ratification by this Board, such resignations shall be deemed effective as of the date and time of the Superintendent's acceptance.
  - 8. <u>Agents of the Board</u>: Authorization to designate and authorize the Superintendent, or his designee, and the Treasurer to act as agents of the Board of Education in the application of all grants; to authorize the completion of all grant applications; and to authorize the Treasurer to

appropriate funds for grants awarded, including the advancement of funds for later reimbursement when required by grant terms, without further Board approval.

- 9. <u>Debt Service Resolution</u>: Authorization for the Treasurer to complete all necessary fund-to-fund transfers to pay debt obligations.
- 10. <u>Donations to the Ashland City School District Resolution</u>: Authorization for the Superintendent and Treasurer to accept all donations to the school district on behalf of the Board of Education.
- 11. <u>Appropriation Resolution Modifications</u>: Authorization for the Treasurer to modify the appropriation resolution to re-direct funds previously appropriated to other appropriation accounts as requested by the Superintendent or his designee, provided that total fund appropriations are not increased and that the modifications are presented to the Board for ratification on or before the last day of the fiscal year.

Public hearing was held at 12:00 Noon on January 3, 2024–Motion carried 5-0.
- X. <u>MINIMUM WAGE</u> 2024-01-008 Mr. Wash motioned; second by Mr. Summers to approve a change in the classified substitute pay rate to \$10.45 per hour. This rate increase is in accordance with the State of Ohio minimum wage increase effective January 1, 2024. The substitute categories that will be affected are CBI, COE, ISD Parapro, Noon Duty, Bus Duty, Summer Workers in addition to Casual Field Technicians. Motion carried 5-0.
- XI. <u>NUTRITION STANDARDS POLICY</u> 2024-01-009 Mrs. Mowry motioned; second by Mrs. Deppert to approve a nutrition standards policy that considers the requirements of Ohio Revised Code 3313.814 and governs the types of food and beverages that may be sold on the premises of the Ashland City School District. Motion carried 5-0.
- XII. <u>PUBLIC RECORD TRAINING (BOARD OF ELECTION CYCLE)</u> 2024-01-010 Mrs. Mowry motioned; second by Mr. Wash to approve the Treasurer as designee, or other designees as appointed by the Treasurer, to attend Public Records Training on behalf of the Board of Education members as required by ORC 109.43. Motion carried 5-0.
- **XIII.** <u>LEGAL COUNSEL</u> 2024-01-011 Mr. Wash motioned; second by Mrs. Mowry to approve employment of the following legal firms for use on an as needed basis:
